RANDY NUSSBAUM:

Randy Nussbaum is a shareholder at Jaburg & Wilk, P.C., in the Bankruptcy Department. He received his Bachelor of Arts degree, *cum laude*, and his law degree from Arizona State University. Mr. Nussbaum manages Jaburg & Wilk's Scottsdale office. Mr. Nussbaum is a member of the State Bar of Arizona (BK, Real Estate and Construction Sections) and Maricopa County Bar Association. He is a former director of the Scottsdale Bar Association. He is admitted to practice before the Arizona Supreme Court and the United States District Court for the District of Arizona. His practice concentrates in the areas of bankruptcy, in which he is both nationally and state certified specialist, real estate, construction and contracting law. He is a frequent lecturer and author for the State and Maricopa County Bar Associations, the Arizona State University Alumni Association and a number of professional and trade groups on bankruptcy, construction and real estate topics. He has authored a comprehensive bankruptcy seminar entitled "Bankruptcy Ambushes Lurking in the Legal Jungle," which is an annual presentation by the State Bar of Arizona in conjunction with the Scottsdale Bar Association, and he also chairs a yearly seminar on bankruptcy Chapter 13s sponsored by the ASU Law School Alumni Association. Mr. Nussbaum is extensively involved in community-related activities. He is a 1990 graduate of the Scottsdale Leadership Training Program and just finished a 4-year term on its Board of Directors. He sat on the Scottsdale Environmental Quality Advisory Board from 1999 until 2005 and is the Citizens Chairman for EnvironkidsFest, which is an annual all-day festival at Westworld for Scottsdale area fourth graders. He was appointed in early 2002 to the Center for the Performing Arts Committee of the Scottsdale Cultural Center. In December of 2003, Mr. Nussbaum was honored by the ASU Law School Alumni Association for his many years of assistance to the Law School.
